

Photo Challenge of the Month/Photographer of the Year

Photo Challenge of the Month:

Beginning in January, 2022, members are encouraged to participate in our Photo Challenge of the Month.

Each month a topic/category will be announced in the Newsletter for the next challenge. Participants will have until the next meeting to create an image that they feel portrays this topic/category. They will then have two weeks to upload their **ONE** image to the Poll Unit for that month. **Please title the image using the following format: Lastname_Topic_Title.** Also, resize the images so the longest side is no longer than 1400 pixels, with a maximum file size of 1mb.

The club members will then have two weeks to return to the Poll Unit and score the images to determine the winner. ***It is important that members give each image a score of 1-5 stars, with 1 being the lowest and 5 the highest.*** The image with the highest score will be the winner.

The winning image will be “printed” in the next newsletter.

The makers of the images will be awarded points toward the Photographer of the Year as follows:

- 1st Place – 5 points
- 2nd Place – 4 points
- 3rd Place – 3 points
- Each image entered – 1 point

Photographer of the Year:

In addition to earning points for the Photo Challenge of the Month, points will be awarded as follows:

- For entering the club competition: 1 point for each image
- For proposing an outing or meeting topic: 5 points
- For actually leading the outing or organizing the speaker for the meeting: 10 points
(Limited to 20 points)

The points will be tracked throughout the year. The member accumulating the most points will be named “Photographer of the Year” for that year, and will receive free dues for the following year.
