Topics will still be announced here and in the meeting in addition to the calendar.

The monthly challenge in November will be a best of the best. All the first place winners will be put in a PollUnit and the members will score these images to determine which the top 3 of the year are. This will have increased points, 30 points for First Place; 20 points for Second Place and 10 points for Third Place.

The April Challenge will be: Leading Lines

The May Challenge will be: ALONE. The image should evoke feelings of being alone.

Please title the image using the following format: Lastname Topic Title

If any member cannot upload images to the Pollunit, that person can send me (trekkielaw@aol.com) the image they want to enter and I will upload it for them.

The top three winning images will be awarded:

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1<sup>st</sup> Place – 5 points
2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 4 points
3<sup>rd</sup> Place – 3 points
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Every entry will receive 1 point.

The scores will be tracked for the WNCCC Photographer of 2023, who will receive free dues for 2024.

Points for Photographer of 2023 will also be awarded for entering the club competition (1 point for each image), 5 points for proposing an outing or meeting

topic, and 10 points for actually leading the outing or organizing the speaker for the meeting. (Limited to 20 points). Points may be awarded for other reasons also.

Also, resize your images so that the longest side is 1400 pixels, with a maximum file size of 2 mb. This will help to streamline the process of viewing member images.

 - b) Must be matted or mounted
 - c) Judged in person on April 1st so, bring them to the meeting
 - d) Categories are:

- i) Open Color
- ii) Open Monochrome/B&W
- iii) Nature (either color or Mono)

I need this information by MARCH 31st. This is for the press release and the event promotional information that Erico is drafting.

We will hang our images on May 2nd and have an Artist Reception May 5th. All images must have wire hangers, and be framed or mounted. Canvas or metal prints are also acceptable. Each image must be labeled on the back with the Artist's name, title of the image, and price (if you want to sell the image). Inspiration Studio will keep 20% of the selling price, if your image sells. I will need this information by April 22nd to create a spreadsheet/inventory of the images. I will need the images by May 1st.

Additional Open Gallery hours will be May 13th from 11 am to 1 pm, right after the meeting, May 20th from noon to 2 pm and May 26th from 6 pm to 8 pm Two members will need to sign up to be present at Inspiration Studios each time we will have the Gallery open.
