Then the club members will have a period of time to vote on the images submitted. The winning images will be 'printed' in the next Newsletter.

If any member cannot upload images to the Pollunit, that person can send me (trekkielaw@aol.com) the image they want to enter and I will upload it for them.

The top three winning images will be awarded:

1<sup>st</sup> Place – 5 points
2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 4 points
3<sup>rd</sup> Place – 3 points
```

Every entry will receive 1 point.

The scores will be tracked for the WNCCC Photographer of 2022, who will receive free dues for 2023.

Points for Photographer of 2022 will also be awarded for entering the club competition (1 point for each image), 5 points for proposing an outing or meeting topic, and 10 points for actually leading the outing or organizing the speaker for the meeting. (Limited to 20 points).

Also, resize your images so that the longest side is 1400 pixels, with a maximum file size of 1 mb. This will help to streamline the process of viewing member images.

The uploader is currently open and it will stay open until October 15th at 11:59 pm. You may upload two images. The voting period will be from 10/16/22 at 12 am until 10/22/22 at 11:59 pm. You will score ALL the images. The top scoring 7 images will be chosen to submit for the Showcase. If two of the top seven are from the same maker, the lower scoring image will be dropped and the seven highest scoring image will be entered. The topic is open. The only restriction is that you cannot resubmit an image that you already have submitted. We need as many people as possible to submit images.

The prints then travel to different clubs in Wisconsin and are scored. We will have a month in which we will score the prints.
